

TUNISIAN CROCHET NOTES

In Tunisian Crochet each row is made up of two parts.

- Forward pass - pull up loops and leave them on the hook

- Return pass (close) - work loops off the needle until one loop remains. This loop is the first stitch of the next row.

Unlike typical crochet, the right side always faces you

Foundation row: Chain the indicated number of stitches.

Forward Pass: pull up a loop in the horizontal bar of second chain from hook and in each ch across.

To Close (reverse pass): YO (yarn over) and draw through one loop on hook (ch 1 made), (YO and draw through two loops) across until one loop remains.

Tunisian Simple Stitch (tss): Insert hook from right to left under next vertical bar, YO and pull up a loop

Tunisian Knit Stitch (tk): Insert hook from front to back between front and back vertical bars of next stitch, YO and you'll up a loop.

Bind Off: Ch1, insert the hook into the next stitch in the same pattern, sc in each st across

Single crochet (sc): insert hook into next st, YO and pull up a loop, YO and draw through loops

Slip Stitch Seam: holding right sides together, insert hook under first stitch of front piece and under first stitch of back piece. There should be five loops on the hook. YO and pull that loop through all five loops. Continue across.
